**CHECK TOY FOR BREAKAGE:** Damaged or dangerous toys should be thrown away. Be careful of toys made of glass, metal, paper and wood. Edges on toys that might have become sharp or surfaces covered with splinters should be sanded smooth. Examine all outdoor toys regularly for rust or weak parts.



**CHECK TOY LABELS:** age appropriate, "flame retardant/Flame resistant", "Washable/ hygienic materials", "Nontoxic", "lead-free paint", "BPA free", etc.



**CHOKING HAZARD:** beware of small toy pieces such as marbles, uninflated or broken balloon pieces, balls, coins, small eyes and nose on stuffed animals, plastic films on new toys, magnets, etc.



**STRANGULATION HAZARD:** beware of toys with cords and strings.



**EYE INJURY:** flying toys may injure eyes.



**DAMAGE HEARING:** toy caps and toy guns can make loud noises which can damage hearing.

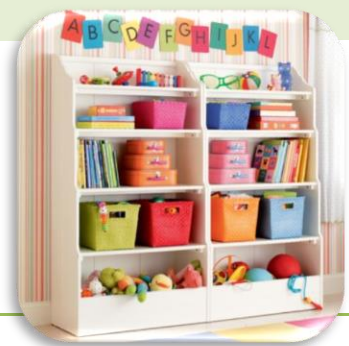


**ELECTRIC SHOCK & BURNS:** electric toys: be aware of its surface temperature and battery pieces.

**INFANT TOYS:** should be large enough so that they cannot become lodged in an infant's throat.



**TOY STORAGE:** store toys on wall mounted shelves, in bins, or in toy boxes.

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### 檢查玩具是否有破損:

破損的和危險的玩具應該扔掉。小心處理用玻璃、金屬、紙和木頭做的玩具。玩具邊緣比較尖銳或表面有小刺的應該磨平。定期檢查所有戶外的玩具是否有生鏽或脆弱的零件。



### 檢查玩具的標籤:

是否年齡合適、  
“難燃劑/耐燃性”、  
“可清洗/衛生材料”、  
“無毒性”、“無鉛油漆”、  
“不含BPA”，等等。



### 哽塞危險:

小心小的玩具零件，  
例如彈珠、還未吹脹或破掉了  
的氣球、球、硬幣、毛絨玩具  
上的鼻子和眼睛、新玩具的  
塑料包裝紙、磁石，等等。



### 窒息危險:

小心有繩子和綫的玩具。



### 眼睛受傷:

飛行玩具可能會導致  
眼睛受傷。



### 損害聽力:

玩具帽和玩具槍  
可以製造巨大的噪音，  
並有可能損害聽力。



### 電擊和燒傷:

電子玩具：小心玩具的  
表面溫度和電池零件。

### 嬰兒玩具:

玩具大小應該不能塞進  
嬰兒的喉嚨中。



### 玩具儲藏:

玩具應該存放於牢固的架  
子上、桶子中或玩具箱中。
